## **Advocacy Committee**

Established to fulfill the goal of effecting change for the screening profession and its stakeholders.

## **Background Screening Credentialing Council (BSCC)**

Established to act as the governing body for the Background Screening Agency Accreditation Program (BSAAP).

## **Diversity and Inclusion Advisory Group**

Established to further the mission of diversity and inclusiveness among PBSA future global leaders.

## **Educational Resources Committee**

Established to fulfill the goal of PBSA becoming the go to source for expert knowledge on the screening profession globally.

## **End-User Advisory Group**

Established to act as an advisory body to staff and the Board of Directors on issues relating to end-users of consumer reports.
